

# FOUNDATIONS WEEK 7 DISCIPLE GUIDE

**GOAL**-We want to stress our foundation that the Scripture is our moral guide and standard for everything. If it is in scripture, it is not debatable, if it's not...it is up to wisdom.

1. **Page 2**-Talk about the movie Luther
2. **Page 5 & 6**-You may get some questions around the specifics of the historical facts of the Bible. Answer them if you can, but we have articles written on each one of the points that you can send to them for further study.
3. **Page 7**-To further explain this chart in accuracy you need to know how things are deemed reliable, historically. The shorter the span between the actual writing and when the writing was found, the more accurate it could be. Then if you found multiple copies of it that match, strengthens the argument for the validity. The more time between the actual writings (time span) and the lower amounts of copies, the more room for error. They could be fraudulent. They may have worn out. Languages could have changed. There are a lot of reasons the shorter the time span the better. If you find something 25 years later, chances are lots of people who were alive during the event can validate the writings as truthful.
